



## ABOUT OUR GOVERNMENT

The City Council consists of seven members, and is the governing body elected directly by the electorate of Redwood City.

As the legislative branch of our local government, the Council makes final decisions on all major city matters, and sets city-wide priorities and policies. The Council directs the City Manager to implement these priorities and policies. The City Council also appoints the City Attorney and City Clerk.

## AS A GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL ENGAGES IN A VARIETY OF ACTIONS

- Establishes policy
- Approves the annual budget
- Approves contracts for projects and services
- Conducts public meetings on land use and other matters
- Makes appointments to boards, committees and commissions
- Represents the City on various Regional Boards
- Adopts ordinances, resolutions and minute orders within the limits prescribed by law


